A Pillows-of-Love branch has formed in Shanghai, China and their goal is to give pillowcases to every one of the 10 million orphans in China. Starting early November, Pillows-of-Love will be opening a new volunteer center, located at 30 East Main Street in Palmyra, in part of Main Street Classics.
